



Pediatric Nurse

Children's Home Society of Missouri is seeking to hire part-time and full-time nurses to provide care for children with developmental disabilities and medical needs. We offer warm, home-like environment with an opportunity to develop meaningful relationships with the children in our care as well as other members of a stable clinical and administrative team.

Children's Home Society of Missouri has been serving the Saint Louis community for more than 120 years. In addition to a variety of social services, CHS provides short and long term residential services for children who are non-ambulatory or have limited mobility ages 0-21 with medical needs. Our center based care provides each child with an individualized, comprehensive habilitation program to maximize his or her physical, emotional and educational growth.

ESSENTIAL DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES include the following. Other duties may be assigned.

1. Assess the health and medical needs of children.
2. Perform or assign all medical procedures and treatments, such as G-tube and NG-tube feeding, tracheotomy care, dressing changes, PPD, PROM, application and removal of splints, etc.
3. Review, administer and chart all medications ordered.
4. Call pharmacy for medications, if needed.
5. Call physician for orders; give treatments to clients following physician's instructions.
6. Supervise maintenance of children's equipment.
7. Chart and document of all personal and medical care given.
8. Supervise CMTs and direct support staff on shift; apply disciplinary action when necessary.
9. Update Medication charts.
10. Prepare written reports, nursing notes, client charts and goal charts.
11. Provide oral reports to on-coming shift and communiqués to the Site Director.
12. Supervise admission and discharge of clients per shift.

13. Take “on call” assignments as part of a rotating “on call” delivery system.
14. Perform related work as required or as delegated by supervisor.
15. Exhibit conduct and provide service in keeping with the ethics of the profession and CHS.

REQUIREMENTS:

1. Registered Nurse or Licensed Practical Nurse.
2. Ability to follow oral and written directions.
3. Knowledge of daily nursing care of well or sick infants and children.
4. Current CPR certification.
