



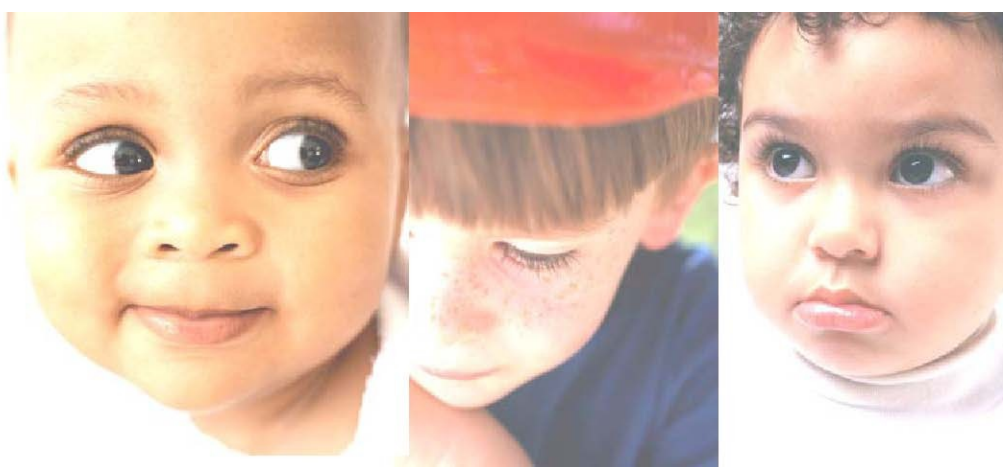

Tax Credits

All you need to do...

1. Make a contribution to Children's Home Society. Note "PACTS" on the memo portion of your check.
2. Complete & return the tax credit form provided by CHS.
3. File your tax return and Form MO-TC to receive an additional 50% credit on your Missouri State Tax Liability.

Eligible contributions can be made in the form of a cash donation, stocks, bonds, or mutual funds by both individuals and businesses.

SAMPLE: based on a 33% Federal Tax Bracket*

Donation Amount	\$1,000	\$5,000	\$10,000
Tax Credit (50% of Donation)	\$500	\$2,500	\$5,000
Federal Income Tax Deduction	\$330	\$1,650	\$3,300
State income Tax Deduction	\$60	\$300	\$600
Federal Tax on State Savings	\$165	\$825	\$1,650
Net Cost to You	\$275	\$1,375	\$2,750

FAST FACTS

- Tax credits may be used for the 2015 tax year, or carried forward for five succeeding tax periods. Gifts made after 2015 apply to that tax year.
- To complete the MO-TC form, CHS can provide a Notary Public.
